**Please read the rules and the categories carefully before filing our your entry form.**

1. Photographs must have been created since January 1, 2023
2. All images must contain at least one alpaca in the scene.
3. Each entry requires one 3X5 card, lightly tacked to the back of each entry with the following information, neatly presented:
  - Caption
  - Age Division
  - Description that includes the goals of the image
  - Camera type and lens information if known
  - No identifying information
4. Each entry requires a second 3X5 card, lightly tacked to the back of each entry which clearly spells out the following:
  - Name of Photographer
  - Farm name where the photo was taken
  - Phone
  - Email
  - Category label as listed below
    - I. Black and White - Alpaca photos taken with skill and technique.
    - II. Alpacas Interacting - Alpacas with alpacas, other animals, or people.
    - III. Farm Scenes -What alpacas do where they live.
    - IV Crias - Those lovable, huggable babies!
    - V. Humor - What do alpacas do that make us laugh?
    - Digitally Manipulated - Photographs that are manipulated



5. Deadlines· Mail-in entries must be registered no later than April 9, 2024.· All mail-in entries must be properly packaged and include return labels and postage in order to be returned. Be sure to include sufficient postage for ribbons!
6. Entry Fees are \$15 per entry for Adult division entries.
7. All Junior entries are free.
8. Images must be previously unpublished
9. Judging Process
  - All entries will be judged according to the category it is entered in based upon:
  - Content, composition and creativity.
  - How well the piece relates to the subject of the category.
10. The judge may change the category of an item at his/her discretion.
11. Caption and Description is part of the scoring process
12. **All photographs must be 8 x 10 printed on photo paper, matted on black matt board with a 2" border around photo.** (No digital formats will be accepted)
13. Deadlines·
  - Mail-in entries must be received no later than April 9, all mail-in entries must be properly packaged and include return labels and postage in order to be returned.
  - Hand delivered entries will be received during Check-In on Friday, April 19 until 6:00 pm.
14. Entries can be picked up at the show on Sunday, April 21, after 1:00 pm
